## **Call for Papers – Methods XVII proceedings**

We invite contributions to an edited volume

to be published with *Language Science Press* (Language Variation Series; <a href="https://langsci-press.org/catalog/series/lv">https://langsci-press.org/catalog/series/lv</a>).

All Methods XVII presenters are invited to submit their Methods XVII papers. Minor modifications of title/content are possible, but paper titles should clearly link to the original presentation title.

## The following procedures will be adopted:

- submissions should be between **5,000 and 10,000 words** in length (total word count **including** references)
- authors submitting a paper **commit themselves to peer-reviewing** a maximum of 2 papers submitted to the volume
- authors must suggest 2 peers who can be consulted for an external review (please note that contributors to the volume are considered internal reviewers, so check with colleagues whether they are contributing themselves before providing their names as reviewers)
- the reviewers suggested should be free of any conflicts of interest as defined e.g. by the German Research Foundation (<a href="https://www.dfg.de/formulare/10">https://www.dfg.de/formulare/10</a> 201/; not supervisors, recent co-authors, etc.)

## **Technical prerequisites:**

- all submissions must be based on one of the templates available on the *Language*Science Press website (<a href="https://langsci-press.org/templatesAndTools">https://langsci-press.org/templatesAndTools</a>); templates for LaTeX, Microsoft Word and LibreOffice/OpenOffice are available
- if authors are familiar with LaTex, please use the LaTex template
- submissions that do not use the respective templates will not be reviewed
- please submit your paper(s) through https://www.umfrageonline.com/s/MethodsXVIIproceedings
- **submission deadline**: December 31, 2022

## **Reviewing procedure:**

- all papers will be reviewed by an internal (i.e. another Methods XVII presenter) and an external reviewer
- all papers will also be reviewed by the editors
- depending on number and quality of submissions, papers with high relevance to the conference theme ((Dia)lects in the 21st century) will be given preference in the ultimate selection process
- there is no pre-defined number of articles that will be accepted
